



Cumbria Amateur Swimming Association Records Policy

Junior County Records – ‘Historic Records’ – Change of Policy up to 31st Dec 2018

The Cumbria Exec in response to a number of queries regarding ‘Junior County Records’ is imposing a temporary change to records policy.

This temporary policy will expire at midnight on the 31st December 2018, at which point the records policy dated November 2018 will be used.

This policy is only for ‘Junior County Records’ and NOT ‘County Records’ or ‘Age Group Records’

- The standard 30-day rule will not apply, swimmers may claim any Junior County Records from any date.
- Swimmer / Club must be able to provide proof that the swimmer was a member of the club on the date the record was bettered. Proof to be in the form of a complete member history from the ‘Amendments Tab’ on the SE-OMS (Swim England - Online Membership System) See Fig.1 Below.
- Claim can only be made by the swimmer / family or club which the swimmer was a member
- All claims must be submitted on individual official claim forms and submitted to the records officer by email: janette@pcsuppliesuk.co.uk along with any supplementary proof on or before 31st Dec 2018.
- Any matters not contained within this change of policy, please refer to the Nov 18 policy.

After the 31st December 2018 the records officer will verify all claims and claims which are verified will be accepted and updated on the county website.
